Outdoor 3-D Archery Range Cripple Creek (with 2-D targets)

Season: Year Round Time: Dawn to Dusk Location: SW of town on County Rd 89 Fee: \$5 per individual per month \$25 for a 12 month Unlimited Use Pass FREE for Kids 12 and under with a paid adult Note: You must have your own equipment

This range simulates real hunting situations, as the 24:2-D DuraMesh Animal Targets are shot uphill, down hill, through the trees, in the open, and at different unmarked distances ranging from 5 yards to 65 yards. Once you try out this fun range, you will definitely be hooked! Also, you will get a workout as the range is very hilly! Boots and long pants are highly recommended!

ATTENTION: Before shooting outdoors for the first time you must go to Cripple Creek Parks and Recreation at the corner of Bennett Ave and 1st Street to sign a liability waiver, get a copy of the range safety rules, pay the fee, and get directions to the range.

Disc Golf Course

Challenge your friends or co-workers to a little friendly competition at our 18-hole disc golf course. This course was designed to take in all of the beauty of the surrounding area. Play with your own set of discs, or stop by Parks and Recreation and rent a set from us for a \$10 deposit.

Dog Park

Is your "best friend" in need of some free space? Our Dog Park is just the place for him/her. We welcome all wellbehaved dogs and their owners to enjoy our new park. All dogs must be on a leash until inside the unleashing area. We provide waste bags on site and ask that you clean up after your dog.

Sledding Hill

We've added some winter fun to Cripple Creek. We now have a hill dedicated to sledding/tubing. So, stop by, weather permitting, and enjoy the thrill sledding has to offer. Also, remember to dress in layers and wear sun screen as the Colorado weather can change at anytime. Please note, this is a use at your own risk activity.

Hiking/Biking Trail

Gold Camp Trail

Spur of the American Discovery Trail

You can almost hear the burdened footsteps of hopeful miners making their way through Poverty Gulch as you enjoy Gold Camp Trail. This year-round, non-motorized trail offers a unique view of area historic sites and a functioning mining operation. The trail winds through Poverty Gulch, where Bob Womack first discovered gold in 1890. Start at the Cripple Creek Welcome Center at North 5th St and Bennett, (offering convenient off-street parking) the Laura Bridge on South 2nd St, or the top of Hoosier Mine Pass. Trail visitors should be prepared for a variety of weather conditions, an altitude of over 9,000 feet and some steep terrain.

City Parks, Playgrounds, Picnic Areas and Basketball Court

Everyone is invited to utilize and enjoy the City of Cripple Creek's City Park and Mountain View Adventure Park. The park's grounds offer a covered picnic table area including several barbecues and a gazebo. Children can spend hours playing either on the playground equipment or shooting hoops on the park's multi-use outdoor court. The two parks provide a serene setting perfect for picnicking, enjoying an afternoon walk or taking a few moments to gaze at a spectacular mountain sunset. The picnic pavilion, City Park gazebo and the Henry C. "June" Hack Arena are available for hourly and daily rentals. Please call the Parks and Recreation office at 719-689-3514 for price information and rental availability.
